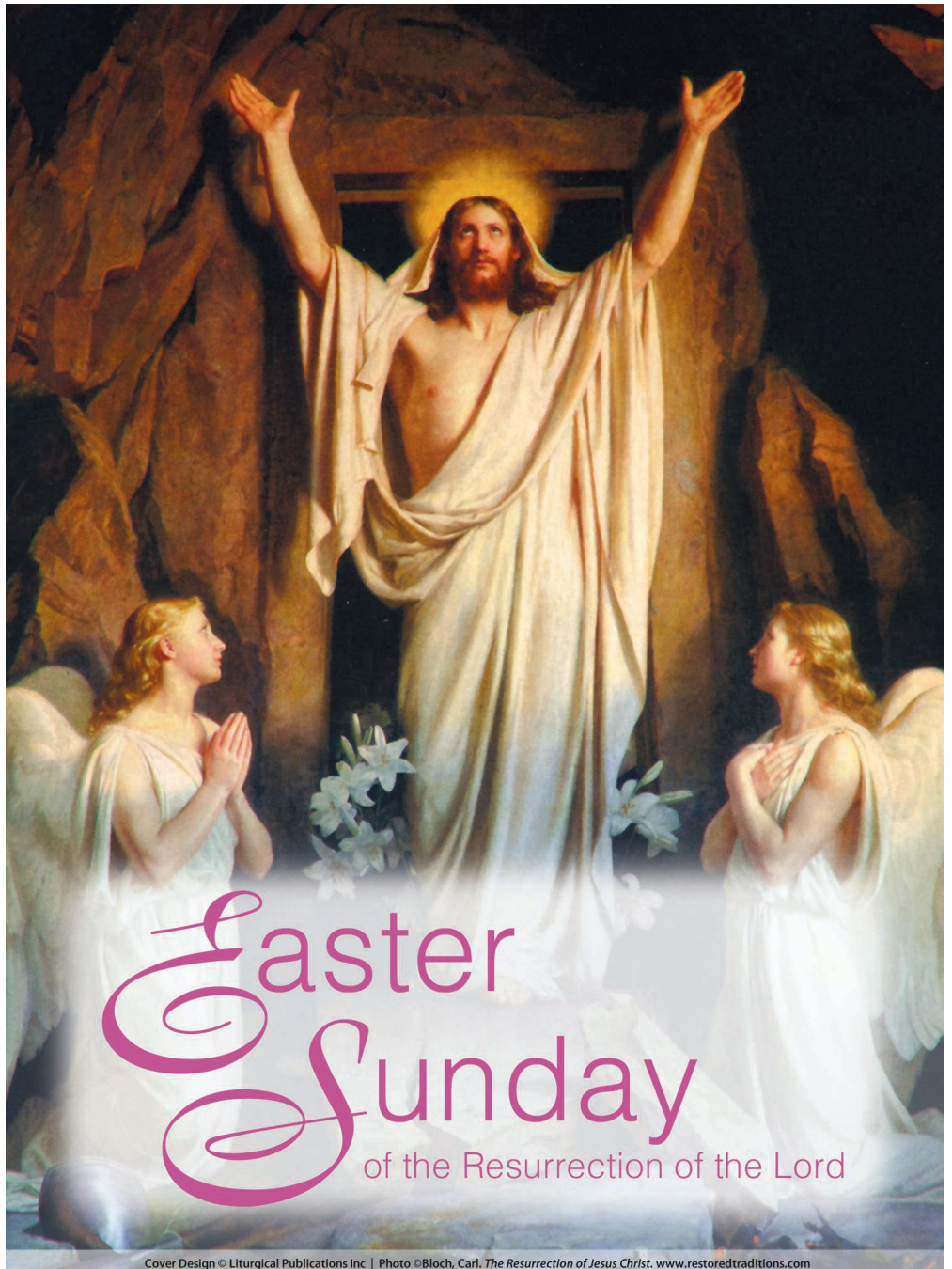

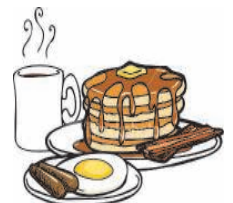

Tuesday's membership meeting will see the opening of nominations for 11 officer positions. The nominating period will close during the May 16 membership meeting and will be immediately followed by the election. 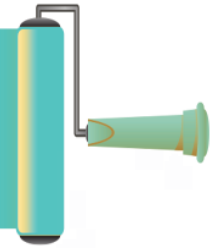
