STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

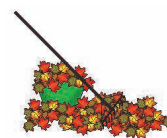

KNIGHTS CORNER

Parish's Pancake Breakfast Diners and K of C Raised \$4,000 for Victims of Recent Hurricanes

The September 24 Pancake Breakfast netted \$3,325 for the Supreme K of C Disaster Relief Fund, according to Event Manager Dave Bednarski in a report during the October 17 membership meeting. The members approved adding \$675 to that figure to bring the total to \$4,000 for aid to victims of hurricanes in Texas, Florida, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. "Many thanks to our generous parishioners," Bednarski said. "In addition to the parishioners who ate breakfast, a lady wrote a check for \$1,000. And a man walked in and handed four quarters to Dennis Weberlein at the ticket table for a cup of coffee. He also handed Treasurer Rich Rosowski a stack of \$20 bills –50 in all."

Financial Secretary Bob Kuhr reported that a couple of changes are being made to the dues packet that he will be sending out at the end of November or the beginning of December. The request for money for the Fr. McGiveny Fund has been discontinued, established as an endowment fund associated with the Sacred Heart Seminary in Detroit, it has reached its goal.

The Take \$5 Fund is being modernized. Established in 1977 – 40 years ago – to provide the State K of C with funds to help more than 50 charities throughout the State, the voluntary fundraiser has been changed to "\$10 for Charity."

The Council's annual Tootsie Roll Sale October 7-8 turned out well, according to Event Manager Bruce Roberts. Thanks to the generosity of parish members, the sale netted \$450. Twenty per cent or \$90 will go to the State K of C support of Special Olympics; \$360 to a local organization supporting the developmentally challenged which Council members will select next month.

PGK Rich Smith reminds us that last minute seats often open up due to cancellations for the K of C sponsored bus to the Fire Keepers Casino outside Battle Creek. If you don't yet have a ticket for the November 8 bus, give him a call at 248-747-6817.

Representatives of the Parish Health Ministry will be doing checks this weekend and then again on November 26. No advance sign up necessary. In 2018, blood pressure checks will be available January 21, February 18, March 18, and May 20.

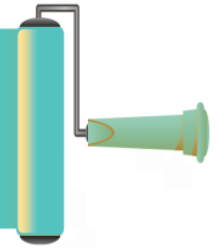
