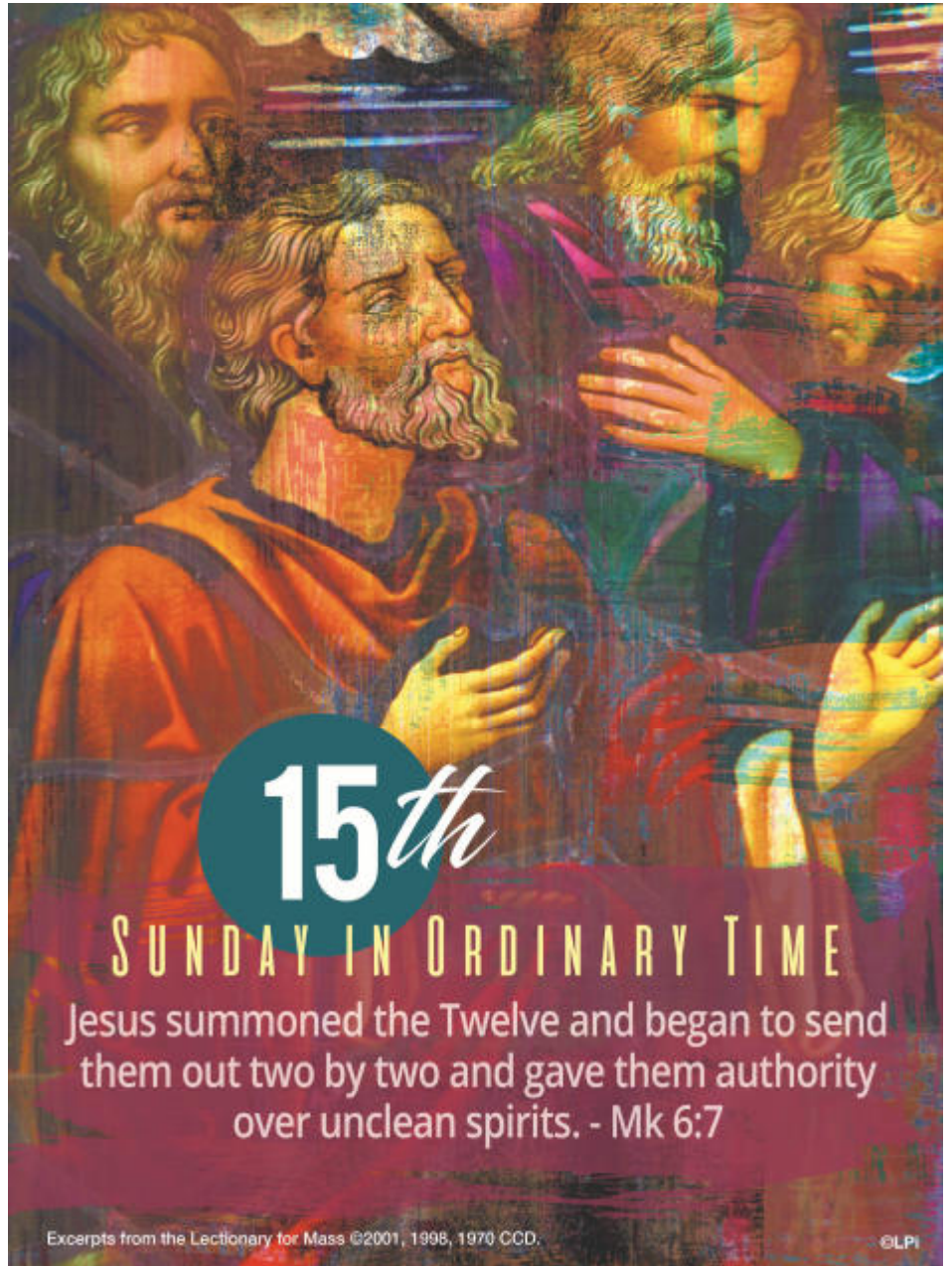

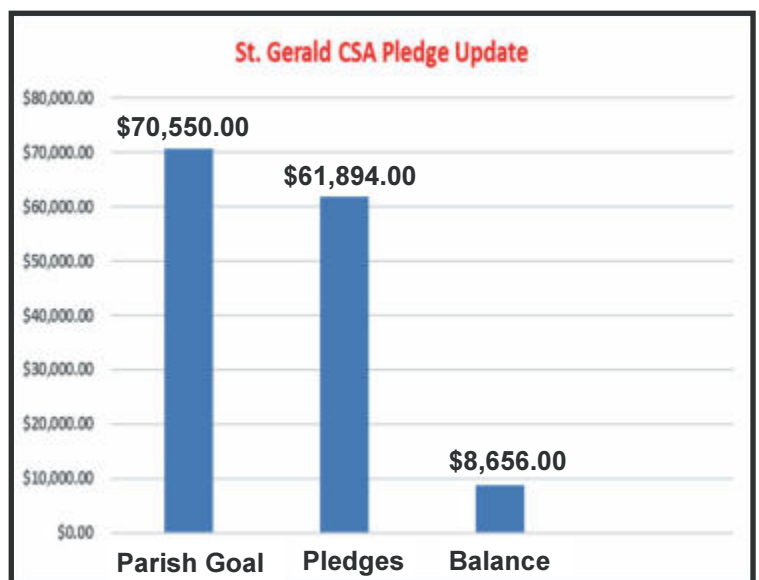
We are together with St. Fabian and Our Lady of Sorrows parishes, to promote the faith, pray for one another and share in caring for our community. See you there!

STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS

In today’s Scripture readings, those called forth to accomplish God’s work experience difficulty completing their mission. God directs the prophet Amos, *a shepherd and a dresser of sycamore trees*, to prophesy to the Israelites in spite of the priest Amaziah’s opposition. In St. Mark’s Gospel, Jesus sends forth the Twelve Apostles, in the spirit of evangelization, to preach repentance, cure the sick, and drive out demons. He forewarns that they will encounter resistance and even rejection. St. Paul reminds us of the Father *Who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens! ... and through Christ Jesus to be His adopted heirs*. As faithful stewards, we know the cost and sacrifice of discipleship. Our efforts to do God’s will may be resisted or rejected. However, the Lord’s gift of grace strengthens us to carry out His work regardless of the obstacles we may face. To help discover God’s will, set aside a few minutes of quiet time each day to listen to the Lord.

Knights Corner

Pizza at 6:30 PM Leads off Tuesday's Membership Meeting when 2018-19 Will Be Presented

Meeting Chow again leads off Tuesday's monthly Membership Meeting. Hospitality Chief Ken May and crew will be serving pizza promptly at 6:30 PM with the meeting beginning as close to 7 PM as practical. The major issue to discuss will be the 2018-19 budget that Treasurer Rich Rosowski has worked up. Similar to the year just ended June 30, the new budget calls for cash disbursements to various charities of \$7,000. To fund those donations, the budget calls for five Casino Bus trips and three pancake breakfasts.

Among the reports will be one from Brian Gulick who heads the *Christ in Christmas* Program. Brian plans to have the Council offer a magnetic manger scene that affixes to auto trunk lids. He also will be asking approval for the Council to join with other area Councils in underwriting the rental of billboards that promote "Keeping Christ is Christmas."

Also, at Tuesday's meeting, Program Director Tom McPhail will be looking for a Knight and spouse to help prepare a dinner for 45 or so South Oakland Shelter clients and volunteers on August 22 at the North Congregational Church at 36520 W. Twelve Mile, Farmington Hills, west of Drake Road. He also will be looking for more Knights and spouses to help participate in the Noon Mass on the first Sunday of the month. The Council is answering a plea from our Chaplain and Pastor, Fr. Kris, to provide ushers, Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers. Training for the various jobs will be provided.

Grand Knight Dave Bednarski will be seeking confirmation of a the Officers' decision to add \$72 to a \$418 check from the Supreme Council for our Council's participation in the Food for Families program and give the money to the parish St. Vincent de Paul Conference. That group has an ongoing program of providing emergency help for hungry families in the area.

PGK Rich Smith reports that 10 seats are open for the August 8 bus to the Fire Keepers Casino. The bus leaves the Church parking lot at 9 AM and returns around 6 PM. The \$35 charge is offset by \$25 in gaming and food vouchers. For your ticket, contact Smith at 313-421-0204.

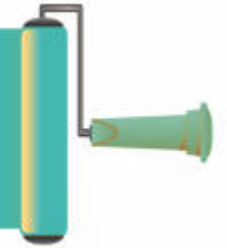
