

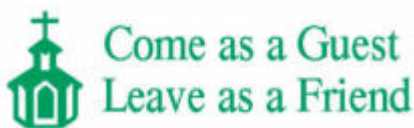

A COLLECTION TO SUPPORT OUR PRIESTS' RETIREMENT

The Archdiocese is blessed to have 94 retired priests who dedicated, in some cases, more than 50 years of their lives to caring for and ministering to others. Even in retirement, many continue to give of themselves in countless ways of service for which we are most grateful.

At age 70, priests in the Archdiocese of Detroit begin receiving a \$1,550 monthly pension and health and automobile insurance from the Priests' Pension Plan. The Archdiocese annually assesses each parish \$15,644 per priest serving there to support this fund.

Next weekend, September 15 and 16, our parish will take up a special collection to help defray the cost of this assessment and to show our appreciation for those priests who have cared for us and ministered to us throughout the years. Please prayerfully reflect on how you can best contribute to the *With Thanks for Their Service in Christ* collection this year. You may return your special collection envelope at Mass next weekend in the collection basket.

The RCIA is intended to serve:

- The unbaptized who would like to learn more about the Catholic religion.
- Those baptized in another religion who think they might like to become Catholic.
- Those baptized Catholics who have not completed the Initiation Sacraments.

The RCIA Process is much more than a program:

- It is a learning and loving process in which conversion of the heart brings one to Christ in a powerful manner.
- It is an answer to the Gospel invitation "Come to me all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you. Take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart. Your soul will find rest, for my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

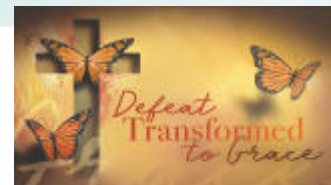

The nonprofit provides free new and gently used clothing and sometimes furniture to foster children.

If you miss that opportunity to volunteer, give Frank a call at 248-982-7782. As always, your Council red shirt and apron make up the uniform of the day. If you have worked prior Council events but haven't been awarded an apron, check with Program Director Tom McPhail. It may be that you have not attained the Third Degree of our Order.

The September 18 Membership Meeting is a Meeting Chow night. We will be serving corn on the cob, hot dogs and a salad at 6:30 PM. The business session will open as close to the regular 7 PM starting time as practical.

The parish is experiencing a shortage of ushers, Eucharistic Ministers and altar servers, especially at the 10:15 and Noon masses. Filling one of these spots once or twice a month is a way of supercharging your prayer. All you need is a commitment; you are at mass anyway. 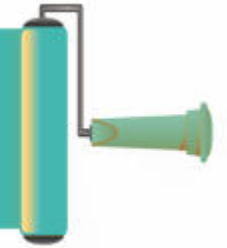
