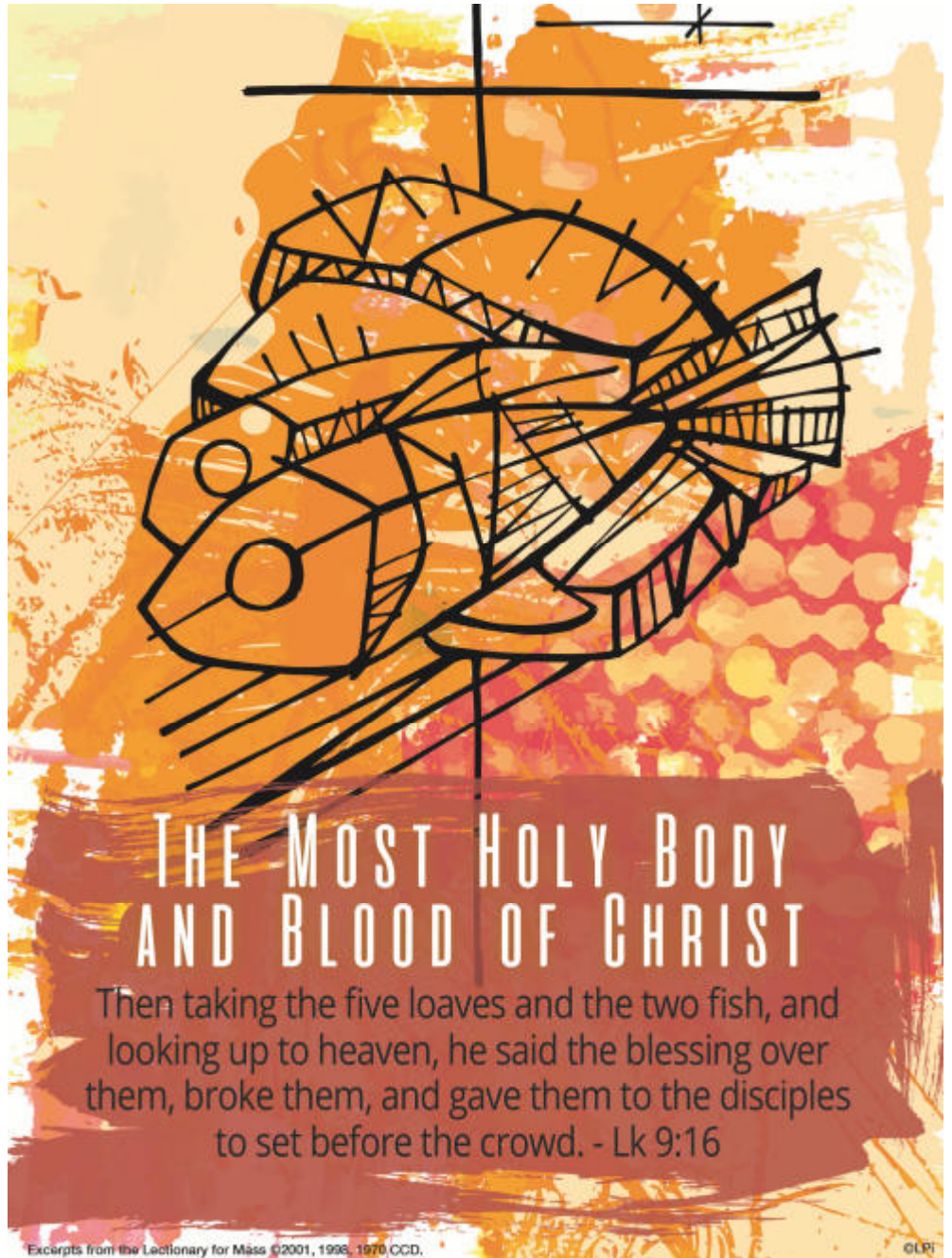

**REMINDER:** Following the guidelines of the Archdiocese of Detroit, children of the parish are to receive two full years of religious formation before the reception of a sacrament.

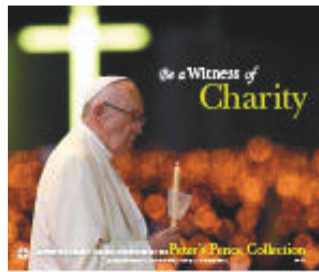

### EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

When I was a child, I can remember stopping by my parish or another local Catholic church to just spend some time in prayer before the Holy Eucharist. We didn't have exposition and adoration much in those days, but we were keenly aware of the presence of Jesus in the tabernacle. I would sometimes stare at the lighted candle near it and know that Jesus was alive.

I had never heard someone speak about a stewardship way of life back then. If I am honest, the primary message I heard in those days was along the lines of "We need to be as good as we are able." Sacrifice was only at Lent, disciples were people in the Bible, and generosity mostly had to do with the collection basket and the poor box at the church entrance. I even went to Catholic schools!

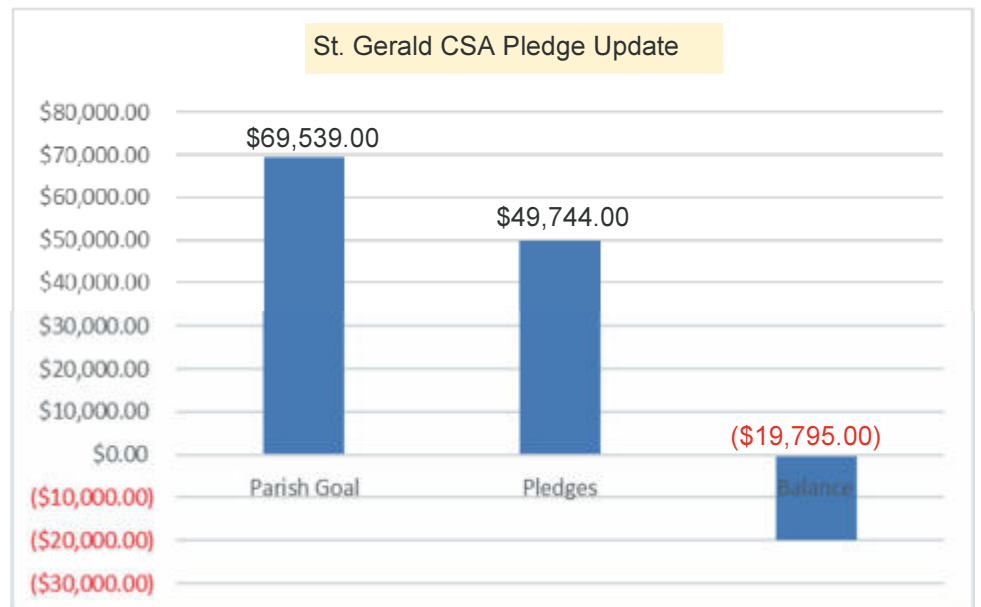
Maybe the message of stewardship was there somewhere packaged differently, and I just missed it. It wasn't until I was an adult, and after acquiring two theology degrees, that I understood both with my head and my heart what a stewardship way of life really meant. But I look back at those days, and I realize that the groundwork was laid for me to understand these things. It was those times before the Holy Eucharist that I began to understand true sacrifice. It was at those times that I began to understand how actions and realities that seem so simple to the human eye can be so profound. And it was at those times that I began to see true love knows no bounds.

**CYO SUMMER CAMP**

Looking for a great camp along the shores of a great lake? The Catholic Youth Organization for the Archdiocese of Detroit (<http://www.cyocamps.org>) offers a traditional summer camp opportunity for kids and families with an infusion of the Catholic faith right along the shores of Lake Huron.

This summer’s theme is 'Be His Light,' and through programs and events campers will learn how to be a light in the world for Jesus Christ and how faith impacts their lives, their relationship with God, and each other.

CYO camps are centered on character development and virtues, which are naturally supported by the atmosphere of camp. The adult counselors and leaders are good role models who help teach the campers cooperation, communication and teamwork as part of the daily life at camp.

The CYO camps start June 30 and run through Aug. 3. Campers can attend mini – four-day, three-night programs, week-long programs or one of the specialty camps that runs for seven-days and six-nights. Camp is open to kids ages 7-16. During the first four weeks, the CYO camps will have co-ed and boys-only programs. The remainder of the summer will be all-girls programming. The CYO camps are the only Catholic camps that offer all-girl programs..

The Catholic Youth Organization also aims to make the programs affordable for all campers. There are early registration, multi-session and multi-sibling discounts, as well as scholarships for campers.

The CYO Boys Camp is located in Carsonville, Michigan and just a few miles up the road North of Port Sanilac is the CYO Girls Camp. Both properties are on the beautiful sandy shores of Lake Huron.

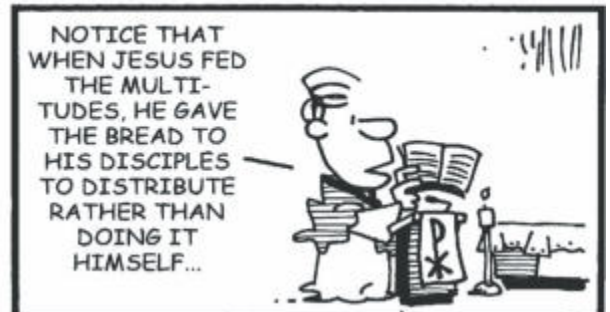

**Join Your Fellow Knights and Families at Next Sunday's 10:15 Communion Mass**

Next Sunday is another Fifth Sunday of the month and that signals a Family Communion Mass for members of Council 13673. We will gather at the 10:15 Mass, sitting together in the right center section of the church. Please wear your Council shirt or business attire with your Council name badge.

This coming Tuesday several of your officers will be meeting with 150 or so officers from other Councils from the Detroit metro area to hear of the State Council's plans for the new fraternal year, which starts July 1. Slated to represent our Council are Grand Knight Dave Bednarski, Deputy Grand Knight Frank Gariepy, Financial Secretary Bob Kuhr, Membership Director Rich Smith and Program Director Tom McPhail.

A big Atta Boy is due PGK Patrick Rogers and DGK Gariepy but for different reasons. Rogers led our first Hour of Reflection earlier this month, using the *Into the Breach* as a guide and focusing on how we can be more spiritual. Gariepy is lauded for putting together another successful corn toss tournament at the June 9 Parish Picnic. The tournament was the biggest ever, drawing 16 two person teams and an expanded list of prizes. In addition to sponsors Peterlin's Restaurant and the Civic Theater, he added the Colonial Car Wash and the Colonial Oil Change. Unlike the first two years, the 2019 winning team did not include a Knight. Instead, parishioner Christine Olesky and brother-in-law David Henning took home the top prizes – gift cards from Peterlin's, movie passes from the Civic and vouchers for car washes and an oil change from Colonial. Our Council was not completely shut out. Adam and Luke Horsburgh, sons of Brother Scott Horsburgh, were the runners up.

The officers have decided to scrub the pre-meeting chow for our July 16 Membership Meeting. Work will start soon on painting the classrooms at Church which will require storing the desks, chairs and other classroom furniture in the Social Hall during July. As a result, the configuration of the space available for our July 16 Membership Meeting is uncertain. The meeting chow program will resume with the August 20 meeting.

Our Council again will be producing a meal August 21 for the 45 or so clients and volunteer helpers at the South Oakland Shelter week at North Congregational Church in Farmington Hills. We are in need of a coordinator and two Knight and spouse teams for this project. Aside from obtaining the food, the project requires about four hours one evening.

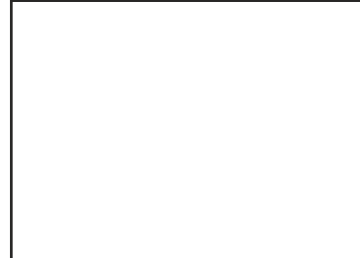

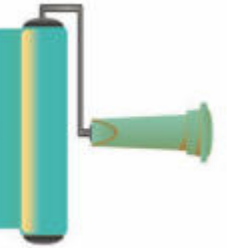
