

People ask at times, "Where does the money collected on World Mission Sunday go?"

This collection, the responsibility of the local office of the MISSION Society for the Propagation of the Faith, is taken in every parish throughout the world on the day designated by our Holy Father. Then the results of this collection is sent to the National Office of the Society in each of these countries.

Then notices are sent to the local Bishop in each of the 1,200 missionary dioceses throughout the world of the results of this collection and the amount of grants available to him. Then that Bishop requests information from the local parishes in these dioceses as to what their needs are.

While this is being done, nine percent of the funds are sent to the Catholic Near East Association to aid schools and clinics that are run by Catholic Sisters in the Middle East where the Christian population is so small.

A determined amount is sent to these 1,200 Bishops for the administration of their diocese and for the training of their Seminarians and future Sisters. When he receives word of what these parish communities need, such as a new church. school, clinic or orphanage, he then requests funds for these projects to the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples in Rome for approval.

When this is completed, funds are sent directly from our Country to these missionary dioceses for distribution to those who made these requests. About \$12 million dollars come from the United States. Five-hundred thousand dollars of these funds come from the people of the Archdiocese of Detroit. We have the most successful collection in our Country, thanks to the missionmindness of the people here.

There are envelopes at the end of the pews this weekend for this mission collection. Please take an envelope home and return it next weekend in the collection basket.

In fact, I have found that I sometimes will even get a strange look when I utter similar words to a stranger or passer-by.
