



"End Dismemberment Abortion" Petition Drive November 23 and 24

A Michigan statewide signature gathering effort is now underway to ban the dismemberment abortion procedure, also known as "Dilation and Evacuation" or "D&E". As the name suggest, it involves dismembering an unborn baby inside the womb and individually removing each of the body parts. The organization Michigan Values Life is sponsoring the citizens' petition drive that would ban the procedure on living fetuses by amending the state's 2011 law which bans partial birth abortions. Four hundred thousand (400,000) registered voters' signatures are needed to bring this measure before the Michigan lawmakers. According to Michigan Values Life," the advantage of initiating this legislation through a petition is that the bill's language cannot be changed by the legislature, but more importantly, it cannot be vetoed by Governor Whitmer!"

To support this effort, St. Gerald is hosting a petition drive on November 23 and 24. Petitions will be available for registered voters to sign at the main entrance and in the social hall after all masses. Make your pro-life voice heard! Please sign the petition to end dismemberment abortions in our state. If you have already signed the petition, thank you! You cannot do so again, but please inform family and friends; encourage them to sign.

Please Note: The Michigan Catholic Conference and the Catholic Bishops of Michigan support this petition drive sponsored by Michigan Values Life. This drive should not be confused with Michigan Heartbeat Coalition who is also sponsoring a petition drive. The Michigan Catholic Conference and the Catholic Bishops of Michigan **DO NOT** support the Heartbeat petition drive because they have serious concerns with the proposal, as it could weaken existing protection of the unborn in Michigan abortion laws.

Pizza Plus Consideration of \$1,000 Gift and 2020 Action Calendar Main Topics for Members Tuesday

Pizza, Holiday food baskets and the year 2020 will be the focus of Tuesday's Membership Meeting. Hospitality Chair Ken May will be serving a variety of pizza along with a green salad as the pre-meeting chow. Dinner is at 6:30 PM with the meeting starting as close to 30 minutes later as practical.

The two major items on the meeting agenda are endorsement of the 2020 Council Action Calendar and approval of the Council's annual \$1,000 underwriting of the parish's holiday gift baskets for the needy. In the past, the Council has made the donation in the form of \$20 gift cards from Kroger and Meijer food stores. However, Financial Secretary Bob Kuhr, who also is one of the leaders of the parish St. Vincent de Paul Society, suggested a cash gift, since it provides more flexibility for the program. Council Officers approved a \$1,000 cash gift to SVDP at their November 3 meeting.

The 2020 Calendar lists the Council activities for the coming calendar year. Of course, it is subject to change as conditions dictate. It continues the three pancake breakfasts and five casino bus rides, which are our fundraising events. Also repeated are our major service projects for the parish: cooking on Shrove Tuesday, the Lenten Soup Supper, the Parish Picnic, Trunk 'n' Treat and the South Oakland Shelter, plus again serving at the Advent Tea. Also, continuing is our commitment to serve at the first Sunday Noon Mass each month.
